MD. Examination Commentary November 13, 2021

hours 1,5 Time allowed:

1 - A31-year-old multiparous woman comes to the outpatient clinic for a routine prenatal visit at 32 weeks gestation by dates. A first trimester U/S confirmed her gestational age. Her pregnancy is complicated by chronic hypertension managed by alpha-methyldopa. Her total pregnancy weight gain to date is 10 lb. She admits to cigarette-smoking 1 pack/day but denies alcohol and illicit drug use. Her appetite has been poor lately but denies nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea, She reports that fetal movements are active and unchanged over the last month.

On examination today her BP is 140/90 with normal pulse and respirations. Fundal height is 28 cm, which is unchanged from what it was 4 weeks ago. Fetal heart tones could not be identified with a Doppler stethoscope. (100)

2 – A 25-year-old women presents for follow-up after an "abnormal" Pap smear. The cervical cancer screening was performed at a routine well-woman visit last week. She denies any gynecologic complaints. Her past medical history is unremarkable. She had a laparoscopic appendectomy when she was age 11. Her menses are regular, every 28 days on oral contraceptive pills. She works As a waitress. She smokes half a pack of cigarettes per day. She is married.

Vital signs are stable. General exam is unremarkable with a non-tender abdomen without masses. On pelvic exam you visualize normal external female genitalia without lesions or tenderness. On speculum examination she has well-estrogenized vaginal mucosa, a grossly normal appearing cervix, without any bleeding or exophytic lesions. On bimanual exam there is no cervical motion tenderness, the uterus is normal sized, symmetrical, mobile and non-tender with no palpable adnexal masses. Her Pap smear showed high-grade squamous intraepithelial lesion (HSIL).
